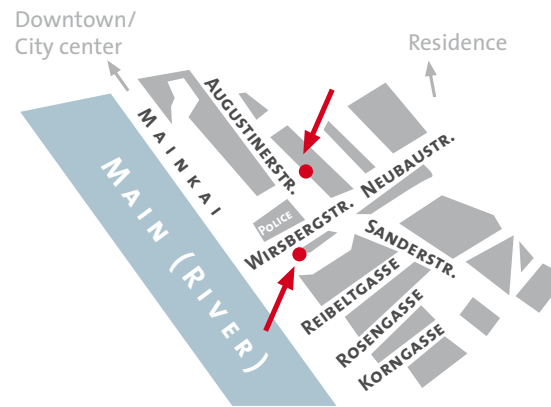
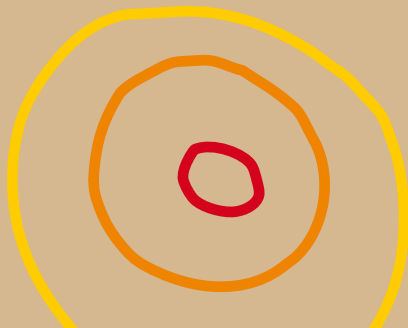

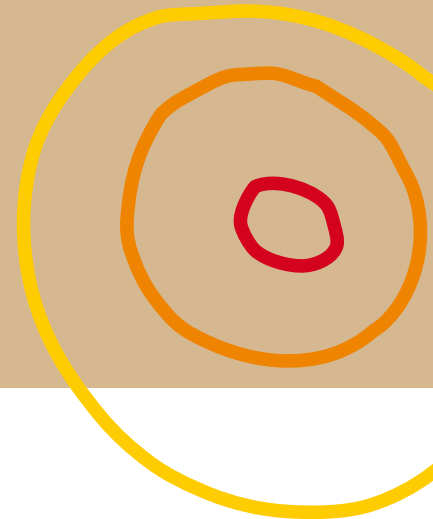
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DIAGNOSTIC INVESTIGATION AND COUNSELLING OF REFUGEES IN CHILDHOOD AND ADOLESCENCE



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WHAT IS IT ABOUT?

It is often very difficult for children and teenagers to get used to life in a new country after fleeing from their homeland. All too often psychosocial crises and behavioral problems are revealed some time after arrival; which can make further integration in to everyday life difficult.

WHOM WE HELP?

The Outpatient Refugee Clinic (Flüchtlingsambulanz) is directed to refugees under the age of 21 years who suffers under psychic problems.

We have made it our mission in our Outpatient Refugee Clinic to help young refugees in their psychosocial development and to provide support in the integration in exile.

WHO ARE WE?

We are a dedicated team of physicians (doctors), psychologists, educators and social workers who specialize in diagnosis and counseling of mental illnesses in refugee children and teenagers.

HOW CAN WE HELP?

- Crises intervention and clarification of emergencies
- Diagnosis of child and teenage psychiatric abnormalities (if necessary, using a professional interpreter)
- Neurological diagnosis
- Reconstruction of important life events from home country and during flight
- Orientating trauma diagnosis
- Psychoeducation; meaning educating their own illness
- Advice for family members, educators and caregivers about a helpful approach to mental illness
- Psychological therapeutic counseling of young refugees
- Medication therapy
- Coordination of further therapeutic measures

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO BRING TO YOUR APPOINTMENT?

- Pre-diagnostic findings (if existing or available) in two sided copies
- Healthcare Certificate (Krankenschein) from the Social Assistance Office (Sozialamt) or insurance card
- Medical history form for refugees can if requested, send by mail – and if possible – filled out in advance

CONTACTING

On the following page you find our contact details for an appointment. The following information is really important for the registration:

- Name, Date of Birth and Country of origin of the young refugee
- Which Youth Welfare Department (Jugendamt) is responsible for the child?
- Is the child's housing in a youth welfare facility?
- Which languages does the child speak? Is an interpreter necessary?
